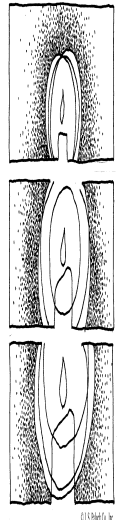

CHRISTMAS CANDY SALE

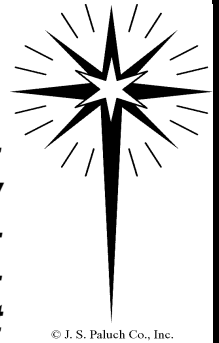

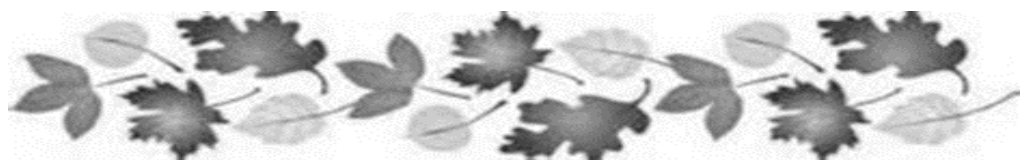
Founder of the Knights of Columbus Beatification Ceremony:

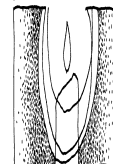
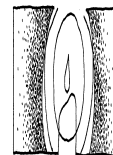
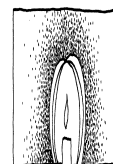
