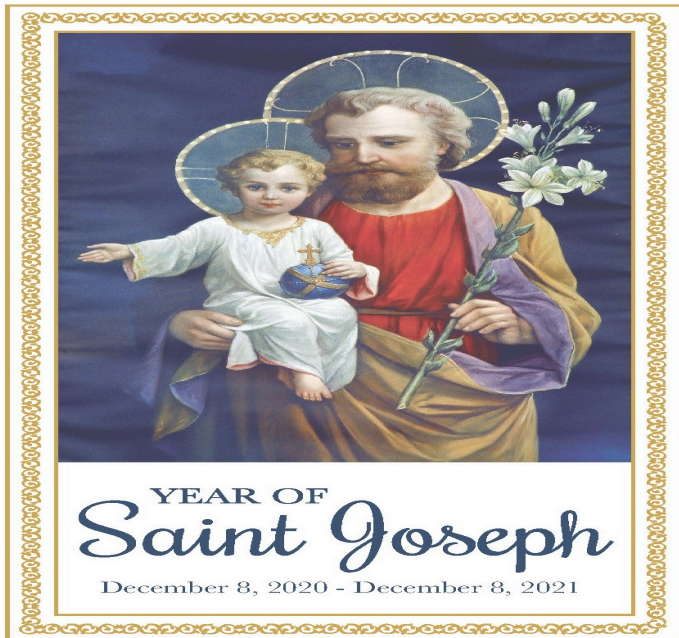

FROM THE PASTOR'S DESK

My dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

Today's message in the liturgy seems to be directed more to me than to all of you! The Word of God speaks of good shepherds and bad shepherds. It is always a temptation for priests to think of themselves as better than others. Working for our own benefit rather than for the people we serve is displeasing to God. The bad shepherds will have to answer before God. Who are we to judge?

Good priests model their life and mission after the example of the Heart of Jesus. Pity, concern, and compassion feel the heart of Jesus when He saw the crowds of people who needed help. He began to teach them many things even though he was weary and needed rest. He often went off to pray to "re-charge His batteries". On second thought, today's message is meant for you. Prayers and support are needed from all in the church who serve the faithful in the name of Jesus Christ. Recently a good and holy priest has died, Monsignor Edward O'Connor. He recently retired and was in ill health. He still retained his priestly heart modeled after Jesus and was preparing to celebrate funeral Mass in Pottsville. He did not get to celebrate the funeral. He died preparing to have the funeral. May his soul and the souls of all the faithful departed rest in peace. That was a perfect example of a priest modeled after the priesthood of Jesus Christ. He was full of pity and compassion. Our job is to pray for priests, that they imitate the Heart of Christ. Also, pray for seminarians; that they receive the formation and guidance they need to be good priests. We priests are depending on your spiritual support and prayers. Especially your pastor! May the Good Shepherd bless you and your families!

Priest Transfers Show the Need to Pray for Vocations:

With nine senior pastors retiring, three young priests having left active ministry, and only one Ordination this year and next, we have the lowest number of active priests in the 60-year history of the Diocese. Please pray for more men to enter the Priesthood. As a result, for the first time in the 60-year history of our Diocese, there are fewer than 100 active diocesan priests (92) to serve our parishes, schools and institutions. In 1961, the year our Diocese was founded, there were 283 active diocesan priests. Please pray for all priests as they prepare for this time of transition and change in their service to the people of the Diocese of Allentown. These words come from Bishop Schlert. Thank you!

Bishop Schlert has designated this year as the Year of the Real Presence to coincide with the establishment of the Diocese of Allentown 60 years ago. In his letter to the faithful, Bishop Schlert writes: "The Year of the Real Presence will be a time for the faithful to rededicate themselves to, and to reaffirm their belief in, the presence of Jesus Christ in the Holy Eucharist."
