As a sponsor of these activities, the Newman Center seeks to build a Catholic community of faith in which students may share and enrich their experience of God and His Church through prayer, the Sacraments, continuing education, and service to others. ### SAINT JOHN HENRY NEWMAN

The Newman Center is named after *Saint John Henry Cardinal Newman*. He was born in 1801 in London. Educated at Oxford he later became an Anglican minister. Cardinal Newman became a Catholic in 1845 and he was ordained a Catholic priest in 1847. In 1851 he was named rector of the Catholic University of Dublin. In his book *Idea of a University*, he attempted to analyze the true concept of liberal education in a university setting. He was created a cardinal in 1879 by Pope Leo XIII and he died in 1890.

*In October 2019, Pope Francis canonized him as a Saint of the Catholic Church.*

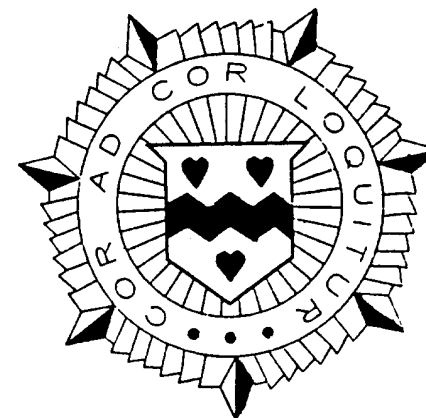

## WEDDINGS AT LEHIGH

While the sacraments are normally to be celebrated in a parish church, the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage is permitted on Lehigh's Campus in Packer Memorial Church. This permission, however, is restricted to Alumni, current Students, Faculty Members, or Staff of Lehigh University. It DOES NOT extend to their family members or other relatives.

Those Catholics who desire to celebrate their wedding on Lehigh's Campus are reminded of the following procedures and regulations:

- Reservation of Packer Memorial Church is made through the Office of the University Chaplain (610) 758-3877.
- Either the Bride or the Groom must be an Alumnus/a, Student, Faculty Member, or Staff.
- The Newman Center must be informed of the planned wedding at least six months in advance - even if your own priest will be witnessing the marriage.
- Permission of the Bishop **MUST** be secured by the Coordinator Of Catholic Campus Ministry.
- The couple are to observe and meet all the requirements of the Diocese of Allentown.
